### HOW WILL I BE BILLED FOR HOUSING?

### HOW DO I PICK A MEAL PLAN?

Freshmen students have a meal plan option of 19 meals a week with \$25 dining flex option. Freshmen are required to stay on this meal plan option until they become an upperclassmen.

Meal plan choices and prices can be see on the *Tuition and Fee guide*.

### WHERE CAN I DO MY LAUNDRY?

Laundry facilities are located in your residence hall. Our FREE laundry facilities are for *resident usage only.* 

VUU ORLH is not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged articles.

### **CAN I SWITCH ROOMS?**

Yes. Room changes can be requested in the Residence Life and Housing Office before drop/add period.

Housing assignments cannot be adjusted after these dates.

### DOES HOUSEKEEPING CLEAN MY ROOM?

Residents are responsible for the cleanliness of rooms, disposing of trash and leaving all public areas in clean condition.

The housekeeping staff will clean the public areas as well as community bathrooms.

### HOW WILL I GET MY VUU ID CARD

VUU ID Cards will be issued by Information Technology located in the Ellison BUilding

### UPDATES

Extended stay is no longer available. Students must vacate the residence halls during the breaks (Christmas, spring break/summer). The residence halls will be closed during this time to allow facilities to clean and sanitize the buildings.



# Follow these easy tips to enhance your Panther Move-In Experience!

### 1. BE PATIENT:

With hundreds of students moving into housing over the course of one day, there may be some waiting times for parking, check- in, etc. know this going in and exercise patience when possible.

2. DRESS FOR THE WEATHER: WEAR YOUR MASK/GLOVES AND DRESS COOL! It's HOT in Virginia in August. That typically means hot temperatures.

### 3. ABIDE BY YOUR MOVE-IN TIME:

We space times out to avoid a big rush of people at the beginning of the day. Waiting until your scheduled move-in time is another way to help alleviate traffic problems and longer wait times. **If you miss your appointment time, you may lose your room assignment.** 

- YOU MUST MAKE AN APPOINTMENT WITH THE HOUSING OFFICE FOR MOVE-IN DAY If you do not have an appointment you will not be able to access campus on your designated move-in day.
- 5. DON'T USE THE EMERGENCY DOORS DURING MOVE IN/OUT It's a \$300 fine to use emergency doors for non-emergency use.

### 6. DON'T HOG THE ELEVATOR:

As you may expect, the elevator is in high demand on move-in day. Elevator courtesy is essential on move-in day. Do not leave the elevator door blocked at any point and time.
